# **Technical Specifications**

#### Double head Pouch Filling machine - 5000 pouch/hr

Machine should be provided with standard batch coding device of roller cartridge type.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE MACHINE:**

**MACHINE BODY:** This consist of Stainless Steel sheet metal built on a treated aluminum machined base plate and vertical plates. All the sub-assemblies are mounted on these machined plates.

All parts in contact with product are of AISI 304 Stainless Steel with smooth finish.

**SPOOL BEARER ASSEMBLY**: The heat sealable film roll of 20 kg. Maximum weight will be mounted on the spool bearers at the rear bottom of the machine for each head. The spool bearer assembly is sliding type of facilitate easy change over the film roll. The film layer is then passed through various rollers and sub-assemblies such as:

- a. End of the film.
- b. Film loosening.
- c. Film brake.
- d. UV tubes etc.

The film layer is then formed into a tube at the confirmatory.

**VERTICAL SEAL:** The film is overlapped and sealed into a Tube by Vertical electrode. The Jaw is Cam operated and its water cooled.

**FILM FEED:** Downward movement of the film tube is controlled by rubber nip rollers driven by grooved cam, follower, sprocket & chain drive and free wheel assembly.

**INJECTION SYSTEM**: The constant level tank with mechanical float is fixed on the roof of the machine. The product from tank is passed through injection tube into film tube. The fill quantity of the product in each pouch is controlled by opening of the gate valve at the bottom of the injection tube.

**HORIZONTAL SEAL:** The horizontal sealing and cutting takes place at the same time by horizontal electrode mounted on fixed Horizontal jaw. The fixed horizontal jaw is water-cooled and rear moving jaw is mechanical cam operated.

**ELECTRICAL CONTROL PANEL:** The electrical switches, control relays, solid state varies, pouch counters are to be mounted on this panel. The electric control panel is at the center of the machine for convenient of the operator.

#### **OTHER FEATURES OF THE MACHINE:**

1. No Air supply should be required to run the Machine.

- 2. Individual head operation. Possible 1 ltr. On one head and ½ ltr. On another head can be packed at the same time.
- 3. Auto operation of the machine stops and audiovisual alarm is given to operator is given when film Roll is over in either head of machine.
- 4. Emergency switches to stop of the machine to be provided on the front side of the machine.
- 5. Suitable adaptors for injection nozzles to be provided separately for CIP of the machine.

## **Terms and Conditions**

- 1. The documents submitted by the bidders should be properly indexed & digitally signed.
- 2. During the scrutiny, if it comes to the notice to the tender inviting authority that the credential(s) and/or any other paper(s) has/have been of any bidder found incorrect/ manufactured/ fabricated, that bidder will not be allowed to participate in the tender process and that application will be rejected outright. The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd. Reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. at any time without showing any reason and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
- 3. During evaluation the Committee may summon of the Bidders and seek clarification/information regarding bids within the stipulated time frame, their proposals will be liable for rejection.
- 4. Inspection of materials may be undertaken at the supplier's premises whenever necessary by the Tendering Authority/ any officer authorized by the undersigned.
- 5. The Bidders should have local arrangement (within West Bengal) for 'prompt after sale service' of the installed unit as and when required within warranty period free of cost. The service must be attended within 48 hours from the receipt of the information.
- 6. Warranty period shall be twelve months from the date of Commissioning of the installed unit from the principal company. Requisite document / warranty papers should be furnished by the Supplier after erection installation and commissioning of the machines. Machines not accompanied by warranty papers after commissioning will be rejected.
- 7. If the machine is not operational as a result of manufacturing defect or as a result of poor workmanship the machine has to be replaced by the bidder.
- 8. Supply, installation & commissioning of the ordered item with all accessories must be completed within 45 (Forty five) days from the date of order. Trial run of the whole unit will be done in presence of Milk Union's authorized personnel. Trial run report shall be submitted duly signed by the authorized personnel. Training of Operation & Maintenance to the operator will have to be imparted free of cost at the time of Commissioning & Trial-run.

IT IS OBLIGATORY FOR THE BIDDER TO NOTE THAT FAILURE TO MAINTAIN DELIVERY& I/C SCHEDULE OF ORDERED ITEM WILL HELD THE SUPPLIER RESPONSIBLE & ACTION WILL BE TAKEN STRICTLY AS PER TENDER RULES LAID DOWN HEREIN WITHOUT ANY PREJUDICE OR ANY SHORT OF PLEA WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED EXCEPT ANY INCIDENT OCCURRED "BY ACT OF GOD" OR NON READINESS OF SITE BY ANY MEANS MAY BE CONSIDERED ONLY.

  - I. Liquidated damages of 0.5% per week subject to a maximum of 10% of the total cost of materials shall be charged if goods are not delivered in time and the amount will be deducted from the Security Deposit and bills submitted by the supplier.
  - II. For violation of any terms and conditions of the contract the Bhagirathi Milk Union reserves the right to cancel the contract without assigning any reason thereof. On termination of Contract the Security Deposit will be forfeited and the resultant loss shall be recovered from the company. The subsequent company will be blacklisted for 3 years.
- 10. **Place of Delivery, Installation and Commissioning**: The office of The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd. Feeder Dairy, Panchantala, Berhampore, Murshidabad, Pin-742101, West Bengal.
- 11. Conditional *and* incomplete tender will not be entertained. Violation of one or more clause will result in rejection of the tender
- 12. The accepting authority (The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd.) reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and will not be bound to accept either the lowest tender or any of the tenders.
- 13. The rate quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all taxes Excise Duty, GST and other charges/ taxes if any for the delivery of the goods in the office of The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd.
