The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Limited invites Online Tender (E-Tender) in Two bid system for procurement of 200,000 Kgs (200 Metric Ton) Skimmed Milk Powder (SMP) in craft paper bags of 25 kg to be delivered in consignments as required by Milk Union as per prescribed IS Standard and the consignment supplied should not be manufactured before 3 months to the date of supply.

4. If verification is successful, the fund will get credited to the respective Pooling account of The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Limited maintained with the Focal Point Branch of ICICI Bank at R.N. Mukherjee Road for collection of EMD/Tender Fees.

5. Hereafter, the bidder will go to e-Procurement portal for submission of his bid.

6. But if the payment verification is unsuccessful, the amount will be returned to the bidder'saccount.

B. Refund/Settlement Process:

i. After opening of the bids and technical evaluation of the same by the Quotation inviting authoritythrough electronic processing in the e-Procurement portal of the State Government, the Quotationinviting authority will declare the status of the bids as successful or unsuccessful which will be made available, along with the details of the unsuccessful bidders, to ICICI Bank by the e-Procurement portal through web services.

ii. On receipt of the information from the e-Procurement portal, the Bank will refund, through anautomated process, the EMD of the bidders disqualified at the technical evaluation to therespective bidders' bank accounts from which they made the payment transaction. Such refundwill take place within T+2 Bank Working Days where T will mean the date on which informationon rejection of bid is uploaded to the e-Procurement portal by the Tender inviting authority.

iii. Once the financial bid evaluation is electronically processed in the e Procurement portal, EMD ofthe technically qualified bidders other than that of the L1 and L2 bidders will be refunded, throughan automated process, to the respective bidders' bank accounts from which they made thepayment transaction. Such refund will take place within T+2 Bank Working Days where T willmean the date on which information on rejection of financial bid is uploaded to the e-Procurementportal by the Quotation inviting authority. However, the L2 bidder should not be rejected till theLOI process is successful.

iv. If the L1 bidder accepts the LOI and the same is processed electronically in the e-Procurementportal, EMD of the L2 bidder will be refunded through an automated process, to his bank accountfrom which he made the payment transaction. Such refund will take place within T+2 BankWorking Days where T will mean the date on which information on Award of Contract (AOC) tothe L1 bidder is uploaded to the e-Procurement portal by the tender

In addition to the above Chana quantity as ascertained through the following test shall be instrumental in acceptance of material.

Minimum Chana Requirement from Reconstituted SMP

1. Reconstitute the SMP with potable water to reach the SNF at 8.45%.
2. Take 1 liter of reconstituted SMP.
3. Heat the sample upto 85⁰C.
4. Cool the sample to 78⁰C.
5. Add GDL solution at 70⁰C at a concentration of 2% and stir slowly until coagulation starts. The quantity of GDL required for coagulation is around 40ml.
6. Sieve the coagulum and apply pressure at 2.5 kg for 5 minutes.
7. Weigh the coagulum and it should not be less than 102 g.

Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders are advised to go through the clauses of the NIT properly and then quote their rates.
2. During the scrutiny, if it comes to the notice to the tender inviting authority that the credential(s) and/or any other paper(s) has/have been of any bidder found incorrect/ manufactured/ fabricated, that bidder will not be allowed to participate in the tender process and that application will be rejected outright. The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd. Reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. at any time without showing any reason and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
3. Supply of Goods: The supply of goods must be completed within **7-10 days** from the date of issue of intimation. Schedule of Supply Order will depend upon consumption of materials. The supplier must have the capacity to supply 100 MT of SMP per month. Declaration of the same must be uploaded in the Technical bid Folder.

4. Time being the essence of the contract, materials must be delivered within 7-10 days after placement of Supply Order/Intimation. If materials are not delivered in scheduled time for which the production gets jeopardized liquidated damage of 0.5% of the total value Purchase Order of per day will be deducted subject to a maximum of 10% of the total Purchase Order Cost and the amount will be recovered from Security deposit and the bills. If the Milk Union makes an alternative arrangement for purchase due to delay/failure from your side the risk and cost shall be borne by the supplier and the increase in cost of the purchase if any shall be deducted from the bills of the supplier and this shall be termed as risk purchase.
5. Place of Delivery: The office of The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd. Feeder Dairy, Panchantala, Berhampore, Murshidabad, Pin-742165, West Bengal.
6. Conditional *and* incomplete tender will not be entertained. Violation of one or more clause will result in rejection of the tender.
7. The accepting authority (The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd.) reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and will not be bound to accept either the lowest tender or any of the tenders.
8. In case of any dispute between the supplier and the Milk Union the decision of the Milk Union shall be the final binding.
9. The rate quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of all taxes Excise Duty, GST and other charges/ taxes if any for the delivery of the goods in the office of The Bhagirathi Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd.
10. EMD of the lowest bidder shall be converted to Security Deposit and will be refunded after successful execution of the contract. EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded as per E-Tender norms mentioned above. EMD shall not carry interest.
11. Mode of transportation, transit insurance for the supply of the goods to our site will be arranged by the bidder.
12. Materials dispatched from the bidder until or unless reaches the Place of Delivery is the sole responsibility of the bidder. The Milk Union will not be responsible for any damage in transit and no claim in this regard will be entertained.
13. No escalation of rate shall be entertained during execution of the Contract. If the lowest bidder fails to supply the goods as per rate awarded in the contract the EMD shall be forfeited and no claim in this regard shall be entertained.
14. The quality must conform to the prescribed norms. Any supply of goods not adhering to the specification shall be accepted/rejected on mutual inspection.
15. Sample of SMP must be supplied to the milk union at the time of tender submission. The material supplied should conform to the acceptable quality sample. SMP supplied after obtaining Award of Contract must conform to the technical specification and yield of Chana as per requirement mentioned above. If yield of

Chana is less than 102 gram the consignment shall not be accepted and alternative consignment must be arranged in due time to avoid penalty.

16. If the party fails/declines to execute the contract after the AOC is awarded the EMD shall be forfeited and no claim in this regard shall be entertained.
17. If the supplier fails to supply the goods complying with the prescribed IS Standard and specification mentioned above, the contract shall be terminated and EMD deposited shall be forfeited.
18. The Milk Union may reject any bid depending upon past performance.
19. The Milk Union reserves the right to approve more than one supplier other than L1 rate.
20. Loading, Unloading and transit insurance of the goods will be the responsibility of the bidder and no claim regarding this will be entertained.
21. Payment of each consignment shall be made after 30 days of acceptance of the consignment in good quality and quality test report of the supplied materials from Requisitioning Authority & on submission of bill in duplicate along with the received challans from the Competent Authority.
22. Taxes will be deducted as per Govt. norms.
23. The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any tenders and to cancel the entire tender process without assigning any reason whatsoever.
