### **Request to Conduct E-Auction for disposal of Scrap**

### **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- 1. The rate contract is for disposal of waste and scrap lying at different location of the Milk union and on "as is where is basis".
- 2. The major type of such materials available for disposal are as per the list enclosed as **Annexure-A attached after Annexure-B**.
- 3. The rate for each item should be quoted on per pieces or Kilogram or no(s) basis.
- 4. Transportation, packing/dismantling loading and unloading will be the responsibility of the successful bidder/vendor.
- 5. The price bid should be submitted in the Performa given in Annexure-B.
- 6. The unit of trading shall be in Rs. per Kg and Rs per No(s). inclusive of GST and other taxes. Bidders need to quote rate along with lifting the materials.
- 7. The quoted prices (H1 rate) would be conveyed to the BCMPUL on completion of auction and the BCMPUL will have an option to accept or reject the price (H1 rate) bid.
- 8. On receipt of BCMPUL confirmation, the contract notes would be issued to the Bidder.
- 9. The successful bidder will have to make the payment in advance in favour of The Bhagirathi Co-operative Milk Producers' Union Limited through RTGS/NEFT within 7 Days before lifting of any item.
- 10. Bidder will have to lift the complete material within 15 days from the issue of the Award of Contract. In case buyer fail to lift the complete materials within stipulated period, penalty@ Rs.500/- per day shall be charged up to 07 days and @ Rs.1000/- per day shall be charged after 7 days. The above-mentioned penalty amount shall also be applicable for partial lifting of the material.
- 11. The successful bidder shall lift scarp material during 10:00 AM to 05.00 PM on working days and dispose of all the scrap materials and Hazardous waste materials and Batteries in accordance with all applicable, central, state and local law and the terms and conditions of this bid. The Bidder shall strictly comply with The Environment (Protection Act, 1986, The Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, The Hazardous Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989 and The Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001, E-Waste management rules, etc as amended from time to time.



- 12. The Bidder/Vendor shall pay amount of scrap materials as per actual weight of the scrap materials weighed at the weighing scale located at Milk Union. For large item the material has to be weighted from nearest weighbridge in presence of a personnel of the Milk Union at his own cost.
- 13. All equipment, tools-tackles etc. and labour required for satisfactory dismantling and lifting of scraps shall be arranged by Vendor at his own cost.
- 14. Dismantling, Cutting, shifting, Loading, Weighing, Unloading, Transportation and any other charges should be borne by the bidder without disturbing the activities of the Milk Union.
- 15. The successful bidder shall lift scrap material at his own expenses and responsibility.
- 16. The Milk Union officials/representatives shall have the right to check buyers' vehicle and inspect the materials kept in the vehicle as per quantities mentioned in the Gate Pass. If there is any discrepancy found, Unit shall treat this as pilferage on buyer's part.
- 17. In case of pilferage of any item of the BCMPUL Unit by buyer or his labour is detected either within the site or outside site, a penalty of an amount equivalent to five times of the prevailing price of such pilferage items shall be recovered from Vendor.
- 18. During the contract period Milk Union, reserve the right to change / modify any terms of contract suitable to our business operations.
- 19. It is required to follow all rules and regulation of government regarding scrap disposal, scrap-recycling process etc.
- 20. If there is any breach in execution of the job as per the Contract terms, the Contract will be terminated without any notice or reasons with immediate effect and in such event the buyer will not be entitled to any compensation from BCMPUL.
- 21. In the event of any dispute or difference arising between the parties to this agreement touching any of the matters or things hereunder, whether such dispute or difference shall arise during the continuance of this agreement or after the termination hereof shall be referred to Managing Director of the Milk Union.
- 22. The successful Bidders shall ensure that no equipment / structure / setup of the Milk Union get damaged due to their activities. Any damages if caused to Milk Union's property due to the successful bidder's sole negligence, it shall be subjected to deduction / adjustment from the Security deposit payable to the Buyer without prejudice to the legal rights available under the laws for the time being in force.



- 23. The successful bidder shall arrange license under the provisions of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970. For the purpose of engaging manpower, the successful bidder shall also furnish the details of manpower to be engaged and obtain the specific job license from the competent authority under the said act, prior to the commencement of the job. The Successful bidder/vendor should also comply with the provident fund Act 1952. Further, the bidder/vendor shall be responsible for necessary compliances under the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948 or otherwise and should ensure insurance coverage of manpower under the Workman Compensation Act, 1923. Besides the above formalities, Bidder /Vendor shall also be responsible for complying with all other statutory obligations as may be applicable from time to time.
- 24. The Bidder shall be solely responsible for any claim, damage, compensation etc. that may become payable to any of the person or persons deployed by the Buyer in connection with the work in the event of an accident or mishap resulting in any disability, injury or death of the person or persons of the Bidder in connection with or concerning the said work within or outside the premises of BCMPUL.
- 25. The Milk Union shall not be liable in any manner whatsoever either monetarily or otherwise for any accident or mishap as mentioned above.
- 26. All spilled waste materials due to the works shall be removed and cleared from the site by the Bidder.
- 27. Bidder shall follow following safety rules at site:

(a) All personnel of the Bidder working within the plant/work site shall be provided with safety helmets. All welders shall wear welding goggles while doing welding work and all metal workers shall be provided with safety gloves. Persons employed on metal cutting and grinding shall wear safety glasses.

(b) Adequate precautions shall be taken to prevent danger from electrical equipment, pests, rodents, reptiles. No materials at any of the sites of the work shall be so stacked or placed as to cause danger or inconvenience to any person or the public.

(c) To ensure effective enforcement of the rules and regulations relating to safety precaution, the arrangements made by the Buyer shall be open to inspection by the Authorized Representatives of BCMPUL.

28. **Indemnity clause**: The Bidder/Vendor undertakes and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless BCMPUL and its officers, directors, employees, representatives, and assigns from and against any and all liability (including but not limited to liabilities, judgments, damages, losses, claims, costs and expenses, including attorney's fees and expenses) any other loss that may occur, arising from or relating to:



(a) a breach, non-performance or inadequate performance by Transporter of any of the terms, conditions, covenants, representations, undertakings, obligations or warranties under this Agreement.

(b) the acts, errors, representations, misrepresentations, wilful misconduct or negligence of bidder/vendor, its employees in performance of its obligations under this Agreement; or

- (c) The provisions of this Clause shall survive the termination of this Contract.
- 29. Waiver: Each Party agrees that any delay or omission on the part of other party to exercise any right under this Contract will not automatically operate as waiver of such right or any other right and waiver of any right by any party hereunder on one occasion will not be construed as a bar to or waiver of any right on any other occasion.
- 30. Force Majeure: If, at any time during the subsistence of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, floods, explosion, epidemics, quarantine restriction, strikers lockout or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) neither party shall have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance.
- 31. Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Contract shall be in writing, shall be deemed duly given if delivered in person, or send through mail, or registered post to the address first above stated (or to such other address as either party may specify from time to time by written notice). Any notice shall be deemed given when received by the party to whom it was so delivered, transmitted or mailed. Both parties shall acknowledge in writing the receipt of any notice delivered in person.
- 32. **Dispute Resolution:** Any dispute arising out of the Agreement, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to adjudication/arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act of 1996 of India. The venue of adjudication/arbitration shall be Kolkata. The language of arbitration shall be English.
- 33. **Applicable Law:** The Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Union of India.
- 34. Other terms and Conditions as per NCDFI.
- 35. The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any tenders and to cancel the entire tender process at any point of time without assigning any reason thereof.
